
March 22, 2010 RESERVOIR LEVEL AND SNOW UPDATE

The snowpack in the Upper Rio Grande, Rio Chama and Sangre de Cristo basins has changed little this past week relative to the average, with a good chance of precipitation Tuesday and Wednesday. The end of the season for snowpack accumulation is now only about a month away, and even if there was no additional accumulation the snowpack this year would end up being about average at worst. Total storage in Elephant Butte/Caballo has declined this past week as release from Caballo increases while the flow of the Rio Grande at San Marcial continues to remain well below the median.
