## April 5, 2010 RESERVOIR LEVEL AND SNOW UPDATE


The snowpack relative to the average has changed very little this past week. There is however an excellent chance (60-90%) of significant snow tonight and tomorrow. So far this year total storage in Elephant Butte/Caballo peaked at the beginning of March, and this past week has been declining at about 2000 ac-ft per day. Storage is currently at about the same level as at the end of January, but will start increasing again with snowmelt. The flow of the Rio Grande at San Marcial has increased in recent days, but is still below both the release rate from Caballo and the long term median flow rate.
