# November 16, 2010 RESERVOIR LEVEL AND SNOW UPDATE

The snowpack is still lagging behind the average for this date, and there is no indication of a good snowstorm in the forecast for this coming week. The average maximum snowpack in the Upper Rio Grande occurs around the middle of April (at about 22 inches). By November 15, the average snowpack is about 17% of that average maximum. While the snowpack has increased by an inch since the beginning of November, this is only about half the average increase over the same period. It is still much too early however to identify any seasonal trend. Storage in Elephant Butte and Caballo dams continues to increase slowly, and by next week should be back above 400,000 ac-ft.




