# November 23, 2010 RESERVOIR LEVEL AND SNOW UPDATE

The snowpack increased a little this week relative to the average, but still remains below average for this time of year. The best chance of snow this week is tonight night and Wednesday, at 50%-70% with possible accumulations of 2-5 inches. Storage in Elephant Butte and Caballo dams continues to increase as flow at San Marcial has been 500 to 600 cfs while releases from Caballo have been negligible. The storage increase has been about 1,000 ac-ft per day, and storage has now crept above 400,000 ac-ft for the first time since the first week of September. 400,000 ac-ft is about the median storage on this date during the past nine years.

# COMBINED STORAGE Elephant Butte and Caballo November 22, 2010 404,352 acre-feet




