

November 30, 2010 RESERVOIR LEVEL AND SNOW UPDATE

The snowpack relative to the average is about the same as last week, and is still below average, particularly in the Sangre de Cristo basin. We are still waiting for the first big snowstorm of the season to close the gap. There is however no indication of snowfall in the forecast for the coming week. Storage in Elephant Butte and Caballo dams has continued to increase at about 1,000 ac-ft per day, but remains well below storage in the previous two years.

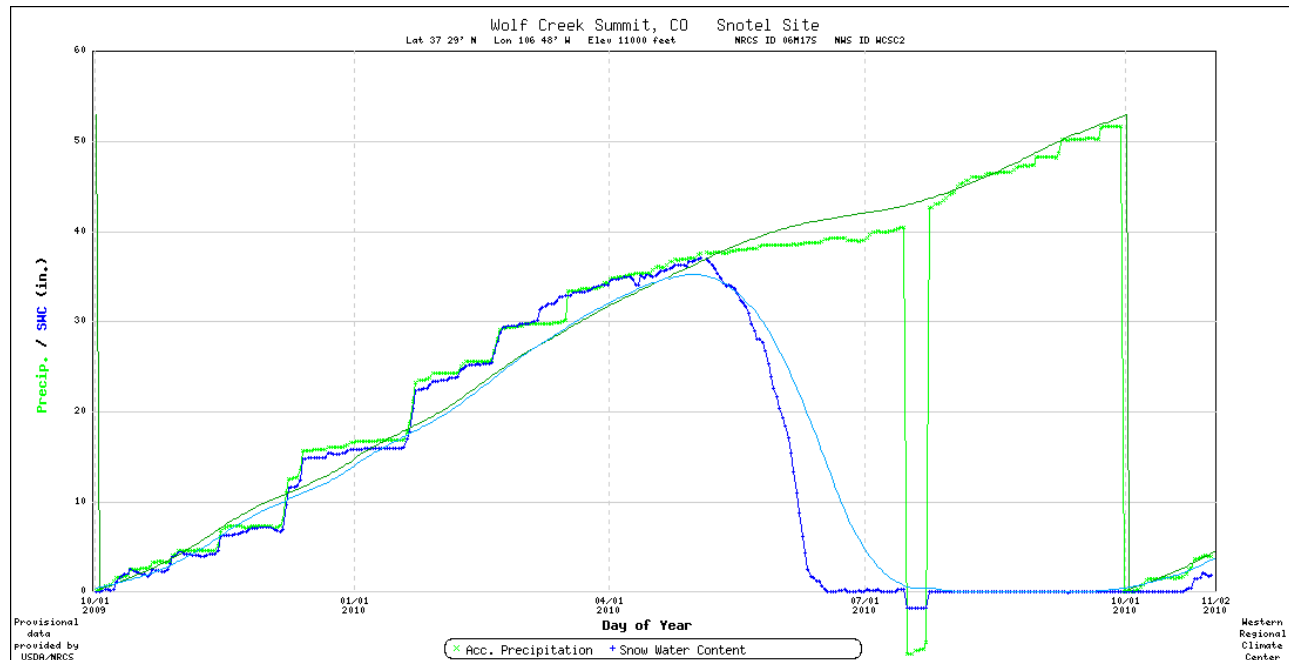
COMBINED STORAGE Elephant Butte and Caballo November 28, 2010 411,394 acre-feet
