February 22, 2011 RESERVOIR LEVEL AND SNOW UPDATE

The snowpack improved slightly last week relative to the average, but it is still average or below in all three basins. In the Upper Rio Grande there is about 7 weeks left until the peak snowpack. Based on records from 1985 to 2010, the median increase in the snowpack from the middle of February until the middle of April is 6.3 inches. At the 25th and 75th percentiles the increase is 3.9 and 9.4 inches respectively. However, the median increase does not appear to be related to the actual snowpack on Feb 15, so the chance of the snowpack increasing by the median depth is the same regardless of whether the current snowpack is high or low. There is a 20% to 40% chance of snow Wednesday through Sunday.


