March 14, 2011 RESERVOIR LEVEL AND SNOW UPDATE


With about one month to go before the peak snowpack this season, we are still close to or below average. The average snowpack in the middle of March in the Upper Rio Grande is about 84% of the average maximum (occuring around the middle of April). We are currently at 18 inches snow water equivalent, 1.3 inches below average for this date. The maximum average snowpack is about 22.3 inches, with about 3 more inches added on average between now and then. There is not much snow in the forecast this coming week. Storage in Elephant Butte/Caballo continues to increase at about 1,000 ac-ft/day, but now Caballo is being filled while holding Elephant Butte at about 500,000 ac-ft.




