
April 26, 2011 RESERVOIR LEVEL AND SNOW UPDATE

There was a late season increase in the snowpack last week with the Upper Rio Grande receiving an average of 1.4 inches, sufficient to bring it close to the long term average. There is also a good chance of more snow today. Flow in the Rio Grande at San Marcial has been less than 200 cfs, well below the median of about 2500 cfs. However release from Caballo has been running 700 to 1000 cfs and so storage in the dams continues its decline. Total storage is about 100,000 ac-ft below this time last year. Caballo is being filled, with storage now more than 60,000 ac-ft, but storage Elephant Butte has dropped below 400,000 ac-ft.




