May 16, 2011 RESERVOIR LEVEL AND SNOW UPDATE


The runoff season should be well underway, but flow in the Rio Grande at San Marcial (floodway + conveyance channel) is very low. Further upstream, at Otowi Bridge, the river flow has been increasing but it is well below the mean. Average flow in the first half of this month at San Marcial is less than 300 cfs, while last year it was 1750 cfs during the same period. At Otowi Bridge the average flows this year and last year over the same period are 1300 cfs and 3500 cfs respectively. The May NRCS forecast calls for 190,000 ac-ft of runoff at San Marcial from March to July, and 155,000 ac-ft from May to July. The resulting predicted runoff in March and April is 35,000 ac-ft, compared to measured runoff of 40,400 ac-ft. Storage in Elephant Butte/Caballo is still decreasing a little, down about 6,500 ac-ft during the past week. The snowpack at Wolf Creek has likely peaked now at a value close to average.




