November 13, 2011 RESERVOIR LEVEL AND SNOW UPDATE

The snowpack in the Upper Rio Grande is above average, and currently stands at about 4 inches. It is still early in the year. On average 30% of the snow pack occurs after April 1. Wolf Creek Snow Resort has received over 108" of snow this year, a great start to the ski season. Storage in Elephant Butte/Caballo dams increased by 6,000 ac-ft this past week. While storage is less than in recent years, it is significantly greater than in 2003 and 2004.


