## Jan 2, 2012 RESERVOIR LEVEL AND SNOW UPDATE


2011 ended without a major snowfall to boost the snowpack, which has been decreasing relative to the average. During the 2<sup>nd</sup> half of December there has been little or no increase in the snowpack in the Upper Rio Grande and Rio Chama basins. The Sangre de Cristo basin received the largest increase, but even there it was less than one inch, which is below the average accumulation for the period. The forecast is not encouraging, with only a 20% chance of snow at the end of the week. Storage in Elephant Butte and Caballo, however, continues to increase by about 1,800 ac-ft per day. Storage is now over 300,000 ac-ft, and the gap between storage last year and this year is slowly closing.
