# Feb 21, 2012 RESERVOIR LEVEL AND SNOW UPDATE

The snowpack continues to remain about the same relative to the average, around 80% in the Upper Rio Grande and Rio Chama basins. There is however no mention of snow in the forecast for the coming week, and if this holds true the snowpack relative to the average will decline about 6%. Storage in Elephant Butte/Caballo continues to increase about 1,250 ac-ft per day. In 2008-2009 and 2009-2010, and 2010-2011, there was a peak in storage in the first half of March. In 2008-2009 and 2009-2010 the March peaks were followed by a comparable 2<sup>nd</sup> peak around the middle of June, but last year, 2010-2011, this 2<sup>nd</sup> peak did not occur and so storage started dropping early. It remains to be seen what storage pattern will be followed this year.


