December 11, 2012 RESERVOIR LEVEL AND SNOW UPDATE

The snowpack remains well below average for this time of year as we wait for the first good storm of the season. While there is a chance of snow towards the middle and end of this week, there is not a good storm in the forecast. Storage in Elephant Butte/Caballo is currently increasing at about the same rate it has in the past four hydrologic years at this time of year. During these past four years, storage between now and the end of February has increased between 97,000 and 112,000 ac-ft. By that time, the snow pack is typically 70% to 80% of its maximum for the year. Whether this year follows the same pattern remains to be seen.


