January 4, 2013 RESERVOIR LEVEL AND SNOW UPDATE

At the beginning of 2013, the snowpack remains below average. Despite the recent snow in the El Paso area, the situation in the Upper Rio Grande Basin has not improved significantly, and there is no mention of new snow in the forecast. We are now about half way through the snow accumulation period in the basin, with the peak snowpack typically occurring around the middle of April. However, we are currently only at 25% of the average peak accumulation of 22 inches. To have an average year in the basin, we need about 17 inches more, which requires an accumulation rate that is above average. However, there is still plenty of time for some good storms that would improve the situation. Meanwhile storage in Elephant Butte/Caballo is currently increasing 1100-1200 ac-ft/day.

COMBINED STORAGE Elephant Butte and Caballo January 4, 2013 171,305 acre-feet


