March 4, 2013 RESERVOIR LEVEL AND SNOW UPDATE

The snowpack in the Upper Rio Grande, Rio Chama and Sangre de Cristo basins continues to accumulate at about the average rate. However, we remain below average, at less than 80% in the three basins. There is only about 6 weeks remaining until the maximum average snowpack, and so the rate of snow accumulation required during this period needs to be increasingly higher relative to the average rate if the average maximum is to be achieved this year. In the Upper Rio Grande, this accumulation rate now needs to be over 80% higher than average. There is a 50% chance of some snow today, and a 20% to 40% chance towards the end of the week. Storage in Elephant Butte/Caballo continues to increase at 800-1,000 ac-ft/day.




