

February 11, 2014 RESERVOIR LEVEL AND SNOW UPDATE

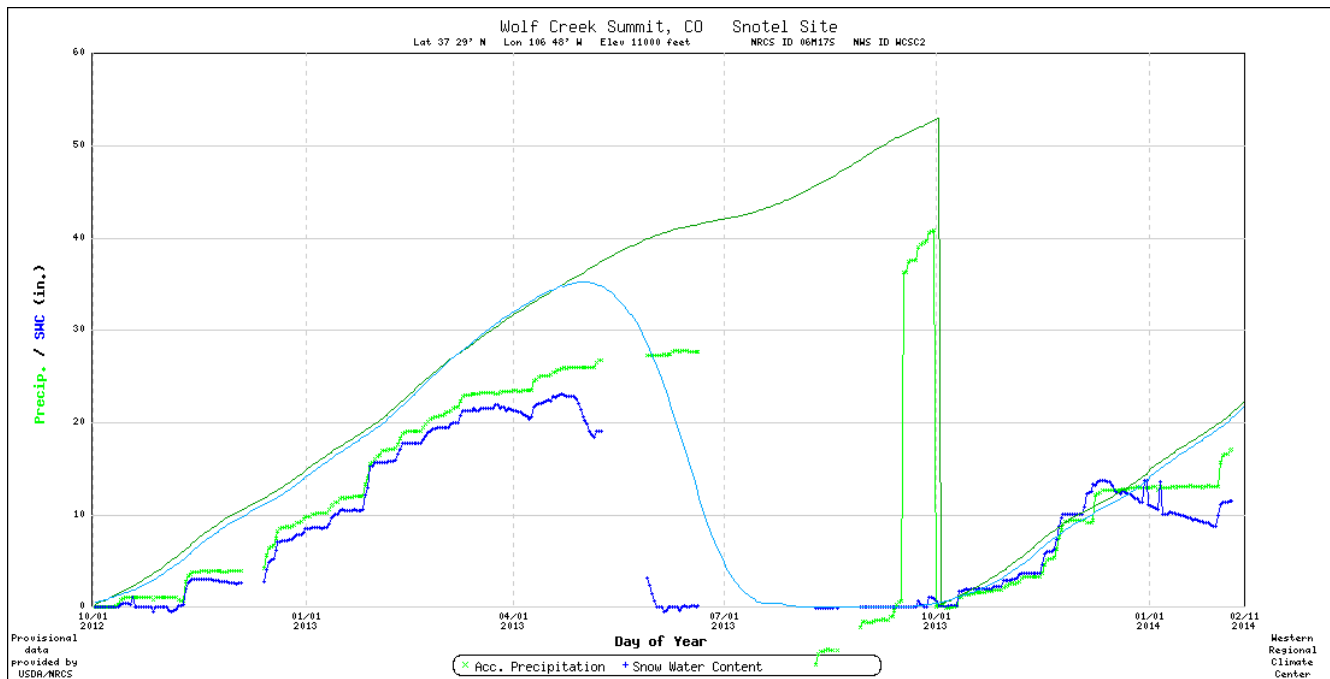
Last week the basins remained stable relative to the average. All three are still below average and, with about two months left in the season they will have to receive over 150% of the average accumulation in order to achieve the average maximum snowpack. Currently Wolf Creek Summit has 12.3 inches snow water equivalent, which is 56% of the median of 21.9 inches on this date. In two months the median at Wolf Creek is 33.5 inches, and so the snowpack there will have to increase at 180% of the median accumulation in order to catch up. There is still enough time left in the season for the basins to catch up if there are some good storms in the next 8-10 weeks, but this week there is no snow in the forecast. Meanwhile, Elephant Butte/Caballo continue to fill at about 1,000 ac-ft per day.
