After a motion by Larry Ceballos seconded by George Brooks, duly considered and carried by the majority of the vote of the Board, the following resolution was adopted:

RESOLVED: the final amount available for delivery to the City of El Paso starting on May 17, 2023, is 21,087 acre-feet for 2023, which is equal to the amount of water specified for a 3 acre-foot per acre annual delivery allocation in Table 1 of the 2001 Rio Grande Project Implementing Third-Party Contract among the United States of America Department of the Interior Bureau of Reclamation, the El Paso County Water Improvement District No. 1, and the City of El Paso joined by its Public Service Board.
