f. Cost Share Grant with Bureau of Reclamation for Water Conservation Project.

Whereas, the El Paso County Water Improvement District No. 1 (the District) is a political subdivision of the State of Texas and was organized under Chapter 59, Article 16 of the Texas Constitution and operates under Chapter 55 and Chapter 49, in part, of the Texas Water Code; Now Therefore, the Board of Directors of the District hereby resolve to support the District's application for a water conservation grant that authorizes the District Engineer to submit and take any administrative action required to complete the application to the United States Bureau of Reclamation and further resolved, if selected for the grant under the grant program, that the District has the ability to fund \$500,000.00 in expenses and labor, and is requesting the remaining project costs in the amount of \$500,000.00 from the U.S. Department of the Interior Bureau of Reclamation in the form of a water conservation grant.

Extension of License 1568, by El Paso Water Utilities- Public Service Board, for dewatering into EPCWID Facilities for construction of potable water and sanitary sewer lines along Country Club Road After a motion by Miguel Teran, seconded by Indar Singh, duly considered and carried by unanimous vote of the Board it was:

RESOLVED: that Application 1568, by El Paso Water Utilities-Public Service Board, for an extension of a license to dewater into EPCWID facilities for construction of potable water and sanitary sewer lines along Country Club Road is approved upon the condition that the applicant meets all requirements of the license, including paying all fees and costs required by the license and providing the District with three signed originals of the license, both within 60 days hereafter, and the officers of EPCWID No. 1 are authorized and directed to execute such license, a copy of which is attached hereto.

Be it further resolved that the General Manager is authorized to sign additional agreements between the District and Union Pacific Railroad in identical form excepting the location of the construction and the amount of reimbursement.

i. Interlocal agreement with City of El Paso – El Paso Water Utilities for partial reimbursement of cost for district work construction of a grade control and flow measurement flume near the Riverside Canal
